Parham has always been a well-loved family home, and only three families have lived there since its foundation stone was laid in 1577 during the reign of Queen Elizabeth I. The Hon. Clive Pearson bought the House and Estate in 1922. The garden was in sad repair and it was revived and restored with great sensitivity and care. The house and garden was opened to visitors in 1948.
